Yesterday at our weekly prayer meeting a friend showed me the deposit from a police officer for 2 weeks of work. Basically 3500 in the local currency. 2 pounds of sugar cost what he earned in 2 weeks. The prices change daily. We bought yucca for 100 one day and the next day the price was 180. So, here, when you have money you need to spend it quickly.
